#### **Homeowner Sign Request:**

The Eagles have requested permission to place a sign to denote their driveway in association with starting a dog sitting/boarding business at their home. Renae pointed out that the covenants require homes to be residential use only. David will discuss with the homeowners.

#### Sanding Road Areas vs. Sand Barrels:

Spot sanding has been part of our plowing/grading services, but the question arose of whether or not it is cost effective. David will discuss with Merle and report back to the board.

#### **POA Invoices:**

Renae reported that invoices should be out by the end of February.

# Weather Forecast vs. 4 Inch Snowfall:

David requested that whoever calls our snow plow consider the weather conditions. If, for example we have 4 inches (the point at which they are typically called) but the snow is still falling or we expect more snow in a short period of time, wait to call the plow to save a trip and a billing.

# Fall Grading:

It was discussed whether or not the fall grading was satisfactory for the amount charged. There was disappointment that the ditches were not pulled. There was also concern that it was done during a dry period and generated a great deal of dust. David will confer with Merle.
