Roads Report

As summer winds down, the board is planning for fall and winter road maintenance. Fall grading should happen in October; the



exact date is dependent on contractor scheduling and weather. Several areas of erosion, ruts, potholes and washboarding drove the decision to grade the roads this fall.

We are working to secure winter season snow plowing services, as well as, sanding/salting services for problem areas. As a reminder, our threshold for calling in the snow plows is 4" of snow accumulation.

SAND

Our roads can become very slick and difficult to navigate with just a little bit of snow, so please check your vehicle to make sure it is winter ready. Snow or all-season tires can make a huge difference for mountain driving in the winter. Also, please note the sand barrels around the neighborhood near many of the more challenging areas. A little bit of the sand/salt mixture can help gain traction when the roads are slick.

Please check your speed on neighborhood roads. Speeding through the neighborhood at 30-40 mph, like I've seen some drivers doing, is not only dangerous, but causes our roads to deteriorate quickly.

Thank you to homeowners who have worked to keep their culverts and driveway ditches clear allowing water to stay in the ditches and reduce road erosion.

As always, please let me know if you see a road problem or have a suggestion for improving the roads.

Traction Law Reminder

As a reminder, please note Colorado's Traction Law applies to all drivers using State highways.

During winter storms, or when conditions require, CDOT will implement the Traction Law. During a Traction Law, all motorists are required to have EITHER:

- 1. 4WD or AWD vehicle and 3/16" tread depth
- 2. Tires with a mud and snow designation (M+S icon) and 3/16" tread depth
- 3. Winter tires (mountain-snowflake icon) and 3/16" tread depth
- 4. Tires with an all-weather rating by the manufacturer and 3/16" tread depth
- 5. Chains or an approved alternative traction device

We have many new residents and being on the Board is a great way to learn about our community, meet people and help make decisions that affect us all.


