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Fiber Optic Internet Access Project Update

Due to some challenges uncovered during the permitting stage of the project, construction that was to have begun by now has unfortunately been delayed. Highline (formerly SPT) is continuing to work with CORE Electric to resolve these issues and proceed with construction. The following update and revised schedule have been provided by Highline.

We are gradually making progress with CORE Electric on the pole attachment requirements necessary to complete the project, meanwhile we are working with Park County and Jefferson County on obtaining permits necessary to install buried infrastructure. Based on the current environment, below is a deployment schedule to complete the project.

- 1. Construction Permits Buried & Aerial: In Progress
- 2. Estimated Construction Start Date: May 1, 2024 beginning with a fiber route to the Staunton State Park Visitor Center and then continuing on in the sequence illustrated 1-18 in the attached map, please note the sequence may change based on challenges and delays with permitting, we will share a more defined schedule as we receive permits. In the event we obtain permits sooner, we will begin the project at this time. Please note that we will be activating customers as we install the mainline fiber construction.
- 3. Estimated Completion Date: August 31, 2025.

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Neighborhood Courtesy Reminders

Dog walkers – Please pick up and properly dispose of dog poop rather than leaving it on our roadways.

Trash containers – Please refrain from leaving emptied trash containers on the roadside for days after trash pick-up.

Slow down – Please monitor your speed when driving on neighborhood roads. Respecting the posted 15 mph speed limit reduces road dust, minimizes wash boarding and is safer for everyone using the roads.

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Frequently Asked Questions

Where can I get a directory with neighbor's emails or phone numbers?

The on-line directory previously available through a link on the POA web site is no longer supported. Although our new PayHOA platform does include an integrated on-line neighborhood directory, we cannot make it available to residents until the vendor upgrades their application to support opt-in/opt-out preferences (required by law). Stay tuned for an announcement when we can once again make a directory available.

When will they be coming through the neighborhood again to pick up slash piles?

Elk Creek Fire has for the past few years offered and conducted free slash pile chipping for all residents in the fire district. Chipping reservations are limited to those that successfully sign up on the fire department web site, and the program has concluded for this year. We anticipate they will re-open reservations for the 2024 season in February. Watch for a POA announcement when we get word on next year's program.

When will road base be applied on my road?

For the past 5 years the POA has been progressively applying new road base to neighborhood roads in conjunction with road grading. To fund this road improvement within our annual operating budget we have prioritized road sections to receive road base application based upon traffic volume and road surface condition – *worst first*. If your section of road has not yet received road base, please be patient, road maintenance plans include continued progress through the neighborhood as funding allows.

Why is my road not plowed every snowfall?

Policy for snow plowing is that we activate our contractor only when snow accumulation reaches a depth of 4 inches as measured at the mailboxes. We do have several residents in the neighborhood that use their own equipment to plow neighborhood roads of *their choosing*. This may create the illusion that the POA is *selectively* plowing some roads and not others – such is not the case. If snowfall is sufficient, all 6.5 miles of public roadways will be plowed by the POA contractor.

When is the next Annual Members Meeting?

After a couple years of Covid-induced scheduling changes, we are back on track with annual member meetings each May. Watch for the announcement in a future newsletter and mailing (required by law) with the date, location and agenda as we get closer to May 2024.
