  - 4. What would you like to do that you can't (for example streaming, gaming, home security cameras, manage large file downloads, home education, teleconferencing, cellphone service boosting, etc.)?
  - 5. Does poor internet impact your healthcare/telemedicine, your child's education, work, teleconferencing, etc.?
  - 6. How would better internet change your lifestyle?
- If you have a business, please write a letter from your business. Letters from businesses and municipalities have a lot of weight.
- Property value is not the message they want to hear.
- Include the name of your neighborhood and your address.
